

Instructor- Student Responsibilities

The **Student** is responsible for attending classes *on time*, fully prepared. This also includes returning from breaks and lunch. If a student is late for class, he/she will be marked *TARDY*. Students must call Guiding Lights at 919-371-2062 if he/she is going to be late or absent. **The children of students are not allowed in class.**

The **Instructor** is responsible for being prepared for each class, starting the class on time, and providing a full period of effective instruction throughout the course. The instructor will maintain an accurate record of attendance on all students and will consult with Program Coordinator and the students on any problems with attendance or grades.

ATTENDANCE:

If a student is tardy more than **2** times he/she will be dismissed from the program. This also includes returning from break.

A student may **Not miss any portion of clinical.**

If any student misses more than **4** hours of the course, he/she will be dismissed from the program.
